

## **DOWN SYNDROME FACTS**

Down Syndrome occurs when an individual has an extra copy of the 21st chromosome.

Down Syndrome is the most commonly occurring chromosomal condition. 1 in 800 babies is born with Down syndrome each year, with over 400,000 individuals living in the U.S. today.

Individuals with Down syndrome have an increased risk for congenital heart defects and respiratory, GI, and hearing problems. They have an increased risk of Alzheimer's Disease, Leukemia, and Thyroid conditions.

People with Down syndrome can lead fulfilling and productive lives when they have access to quality educational programs, a nurturing home environment, effective healthcare, and positive support from their family, friends, and the community.

Life has its challenges, but people with Down syndrome attend school, hold jobs, and participate in decisions that affect them. They have meaningful relationships, fall in love, get married, and contribute to society in many beautiful ways.
